

## **FREUD-DIARY**

**The following chronology is an attempt to account for every day of Freud's life, from his birth May 6, 1856 until December 31 1900. The cut-off date is just an arbitrary decision on my part as a means of limitation. I realize that, this very same project has probably already been done years ago by certain Freud scholars, but unfortunately these particular scholars are not exactly known for sharing their information.**

**Consequently, this is a project that I found necessary to carry out myself. I began this project over seventeen years ago and have worked on it from time to time. This is my attempt to put the information I have gathered into a more readable form.**

**The next step would be to include the dates of all of the letters that Freud has written during this time period. Then, the next step would be to include the days of the week next to the dates. This is a rather difficult work in progress. Strangely enough, it has been said that Freud is probably the most documented man of the last century. Unfortunately, the founders of the Sigmund Freud Archives have frozen a lot of material that will only be released in another fifty years, or maybe never. One wonders about their motive. Was it some dark secret that they were trying to hide? Was it simply an exercise in power? Was it to preserve the anonymity of Freud's patients? One could make an argument for all of these reasons and another argument that it is none of these reasons.**

**One of the advantages or disadvantages of this interminable project is that one can focus on one event in Freud's life and can see what other events were happening at almost the same time. This could be either enlightening or lead to rather fantastic speculations.**
